



“Saddle Up” With North Country Riding Club

“Implement to recognize equestrians who spend time riding or driving but may or may not show”

Rules:

- You must be a NCRC member to participate.
- There will be an additional \$10 fee for this program.
- More than one horse may be used for overall hours.
- There is NO LIMIT to the amount of time you take to achieve each award.
- You can count: trail rides, clinics (as long as it is not a competition in ANY way), lessons, training time, (Ridden or driven).
- You DO NOT count ground work, line driving, any shows or competitions.
- In other words, “your back end either needs to be on a horse or in a cart.”
- If you are on foot, it does not count.
- If you are in any type of competition, judged/timed or a versatility competition that has any form of a prize, it will not count.
- Log to the nearest ¼ hour
- Awards are presented after 50, 100, 150, 200, 250, 300, 350, 400, 450, etc. hours and are accumulated year after year.
- Your time will start October 16 and end October 15 of the following year. You must become a member in January in order for your time to count from January on. Your log sheets must be received by October 31 in order to be recognized at our banquet.
